



Is there a difference between the two? Let's see.

When you have an appetite, it can sometimes be satisfied with just a pack of crackers and some water. Hunger on the other hand is deeper and can usually only be satisfied by eating a full meal. The dictionary says... Appetite... "A desire for food or drink." For Hunger it says... "A strong desire for food—but goes on to say...discomfort, weakness or pain caused by lack of food." So there is a difference.

David (a man after God's own heart) said... "Oh taste and see that the Lord is good..." (Ps. 34:8).

In I Cor. 16:15 we see that Stephanas and his household were "addicted" to the ministry of the saints." That's how deep his hunger was.

Hebrews 5:13 and 14 says... "For everyone who useth milk is unskillful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. (14) But strong meat belongeth to then that are of full age, even those who by reason if use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

If we want to be blessed, we need to follow what Jesus said. "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled." Notice that this is a verse with a PROMISE. Physically, we satisfy our hunger with food. But spiritually, we are filled by seeking righteousness.

When our spiritual hunger grows as deep as our physical hunger, God will feed and strengthen us.







THE GOSPEL AND THE MONARCH BUTTERFLY

FOUR STAGES:

- 1. Egg—preexistence—birth
- 2. Larvae—born again new creature (caterpillar)
- 3. Chrysalis (cocoon)—Holy Spirit
- 4. Butterfly—Live in Him (plan—purpose—destiny)

PLAN, PURPOSE, DESTINY

God had a plan with a purpose; JER 29:11 before the foundation of the world..." He saw what I could be." JER 1:5 Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. A plan for man and a plan for every living creature. He is not a God of confusion (nor the author of confusion). He has ordered all things in perfect detail, and perfect order. All things were made by him and for him COL 1:16. The heaven, even the heavens are the Lords: but the earth hath he given to the children of men. Psalm 115:16.

At the fall things went a little hay-wire...man was fallen and cursed; separated from his creator...his God. Man and all creation must be reconciled back to God. This is called salvation through the "Gospel of Reconciliation". Today we will talk about the "process of salvation" through His creation of "The Monarch Butterfly."

Again, before the foundation of the world God gave all of his creation a plan—purpose--and destiny. He saw what all could be but...there is a <u>PLAN</u>.

God made a plan...thought about it and then created the egg...and fertilized it...which grows into a caterpillar (unredeemed man). As it grows it feeds on leaves and vegetation (natural, carnal) food...as it matures it begins to eat milkweed exclusively. (Milk of the word. Gospel) (redeemed man). The caterpillar having a purpose and a destiny, instinctively, willfully wraps itself in what is called the chrysalis; (Holy Spirit) which protects, develops and feeds as it matures in a supernatural way, while it seems nothing is really happening...but if the truth be told it is truly a time of rapid growth (filled with the spirit) as the rebirthing is in progress. It remains enshrouded for 10 days (10 days in the upper room waiting on the baptism of the Holy Spirit during its rebirthing process Acts 2:1-4). Receiving the empowerment to reach your destiny.

At the end of the process emerges a creation of splendor and beauty...soaring free through the heavens...while drinking of the sweet nectar (of God's blessing) while pollinating other flowers (as we would carry the word of life to others to the hedges and highways MATT 28:19-20, LUKE 14:23). Creating (giving) new life to others as we come in contact with them. The Monarch Butterfly is easily identified (stands out from the others: as we should MATT 5:14-16). A beautiful creation, in brilliant colors of orange, black and white. These color patterns are recognized by other predators as poisonous and foul tasting (just as we are protected by the Holy Spirit) recognized by our predators (seducing spirits, demons, principalities, powers of the darkness of the air EPH 6:12).

They go forward to the hedges and highways of the world replenishing themselves through four generations. The final generation which would technically be (the great grandchildren) return (round trip 1-3,000 miles)

sometimes even to the same tree (same church with our grandchildren in membership), resulting in preservation (as we will (should) see the preservation of Christianity and our family church.)

Sadly, the Monarch Butterfly is diminishing and in danger of its existence (apostate)...because of killing off (taking God out of our nation) of milkweed (milk of the word—Gospel).

As scripture has told us there will be a great falling away of the Gospel in the end times...(apostasy—a falling away of true doctrine.)

When man does it his way

See the caterpillar struggling to free itself from the cocoon (Holy Spirit) to the point of exhaustion. Man decides the easier way must be the right way. So, he decides to do it his way (no leading of the Holy Spirit). I will make it easier for the caterpillar by cutting away a portion of the cocoon (chrysalis) (process of the Holy Spirit)

Wow! By-passing the process, the butterfly quickly frees itself (no struggles, no process, by-passing God's way) BUT WAIT...something is wrong. There is no beautiful butterfly to soar and be free.

Its wings are twisted and dull and cannot be used; the body is twisted, deformed, weak and under developed.




Give them a Fellowship experience MANY DIFFERENT WAYS TO REACH OUT



OLD TIME FAVORITE

Creamy Ham & Wild Rice Soup

Ingredients

4 cups water

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup uncooked wild rice

3 tablespoons chopped green onions

1/4 cup shredded carrot

3 tablespoons chopped pecans

6 tablespoons butter, cubed

1/3 cup all-purpose flour

2 cans (14-1/2 ounces each) chicken broth

1/2 cup cubed fully cooked ham

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1 cup half-and-half cream

Green onion, cut into thin strips, optional

Directions

- 1. In a large saucepan, bring water and salt to a boil. Add rice. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 50-55 minutes or until tender. Remove from the heat. Let stand for 10 minutes; drain and set aside.
- **2.** In a large Dutch oven or soup kettle, saute the onions, carrot and pecans in butter for 1-2 minutes. Stir in flour until blended. Gradually add broth. Bring to a boil; cook and stir for 2 minutes or until thickened. Reduce heat. Add the ham, pepper and wild rice. Cover and simmer for 5 minutes or until carrots are tender.
- 3. Reduce heat. Add cream and heat through (do not boil). Sprinkle with green onion if desired.

FOR DIABETICS

Slow Cooker Beef & Barley Soup by Diabetic living Magazine

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 pounds boneless beef sirloin steak
- 2 (14 ounce) cans reduced-sodium beef broth
- 1 (14.5 ounce) can stewed tomatoes
- 3 medium carrots, cut into 1/2-inch slices
- 2 small onions, cut into wedges
- 1/2 cup regular barley (not quick-cooking)
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 bay leaf
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme, crushed
- 2 cloves garlic, minced

Directions

Trim fat from meat. Cut the meat into 3/4-inch pieces. In a 3 1/2- or 4-quart slow cooker, combine the meat, broth, undrained tomatoes, carrots, onions, barley, the water, bay leaf, thyme, and garlic.

Cover and cook on Low for 9 to 11 hours or on High for 4 1/2 to 5 1/2 hours. Remove and discard the bay leaf.
