Resurrection Power

The spring season has finally arrived!! New life is ready to burst forth after a long, cold winter. It is also the season we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. God has a marvelous way of illustrating spiritual truth through nature. He demonstrates His resurrection power every year through the returning of spring time. Out of the barren death of winter, God brings new life. Color, warmth, glory and beauty is about to come upon the earth by means of a quiet, invisible force which literally transforms the landscape into a glorious pageant of beauty.

The apostle Paul said in Philippians 3:10 -“that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection.” Paul desired this power for himself. This power is unlike any other power in the world. Resurrection power is superior to all circumstances. It is not dependent upon personality, emotions, moods, intelligence, or education. Resurrection power is available to all Christians, in all circumstances, at all times.

Resurrection power is not the power of positive thinking or the power of a strong personality. It is not the power of a keen intellect. These powers are limited to certain individuals. However resurrection power is available to everyone. It is like no other power on earth. It explodes into life in the midst of an empty dark cemetery. When Jesus resurrected, He came out from among the dead. This power accomplished its purpose without pizzazz or neon lights. Christians who live by resurrection power don't use it to advertise its affects. The distinguishing marks of a Christian character our humility and servant hood rather than showing us. Genuine Christians demonstrate the reality of resurrection power through the quiet evidence of their lives: Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

Resurrection power is not hindered by obstacles. When Jesus arose-a large stone could not stop Him. Yards and yards of linen cloth were left undisturbed. He ignored the guards in front of the tomb. This is the power people had learned to depend on. It is available to every Christian by FAITH! When you really believe that a risen Christ now lives within you, then you will expect Christ to work through you. Wow!! What a way to live!!

“RESURRECTION”

The very word “resurrection” according to the dictionary, means to be raised from the dead. Have you ever considered what life would be like if there was NO RESURRECTION? The bible makes it very clear.

In I Cor. 15:14 Paul says... “And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.” In other words, we would all be hopeless.

Eph. 2:12 tells us... “That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having NO HOPE, and without God in the world.”

I believe it may take many lifetimes, or even eternity to realize just what Jesus accomplished on the cross. But let's look at just a few:

I believe one of the greatest statements in the bible is found in John 3:16... “For God so loved the world, that He gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever (you and I) believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” It's important to note that Jesus came from the BOSOM of the Father (John 1:18). That's how close he was with the Father. So, he died for our sins.

If we go all the way back to the book of Isa. We read... “But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.” (Isa. 53:5) He died for our healing!

In Matt. 27:51 we are told... “And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom, and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent.” Notice that it was torn from TOP to BOTTOM (from God to man). That's how much He loves

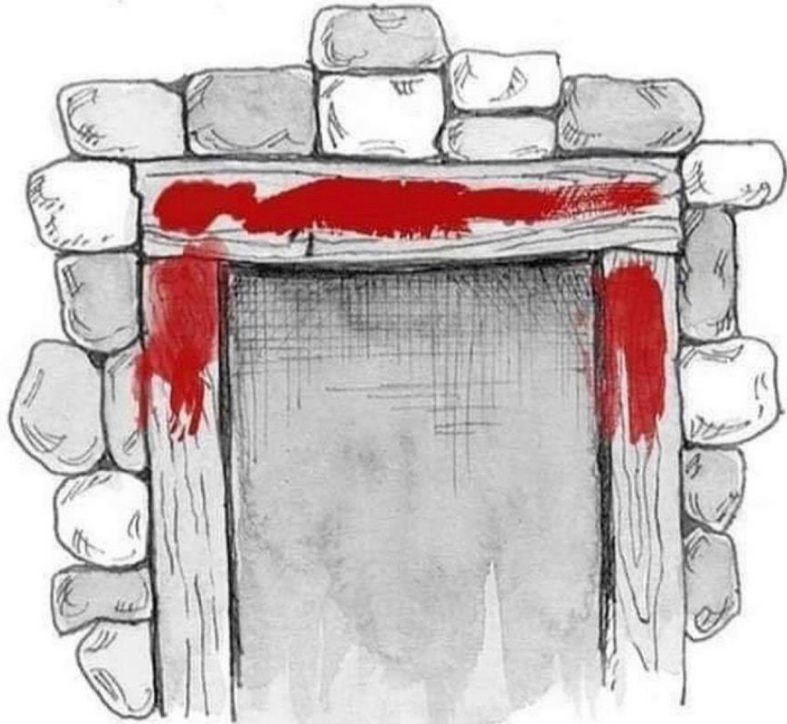



It was my job to crucify people for the Roman government. But, when I saw Jesus die, I was very frightened. Jesus is, truly, the Son of God! *(Matthew 27:54)*

I was an insurrectionist and a murderer. I should have died on the cross, but I was set free and Jesus was crucified. *(Luke 23:17-19 & 25)*

I watched Jesus die from a nearby cross - and came to believe in Him while He died. I was forgiven of my sins and got to see Jesus in paradise a short time later. *(Luke 23:39-43)*

At least two other women who shared my name were with me at the foot of the cross. *(John 19:25)*

I was surprised when people told me that Jesus had already died. It happened faster than normal, which led me to ask for a second opinion, just to make sure that He was really dead. *(Mark 15:44-45)*

I was a rich man and a prominent member of the Council. I believed in Jesus, but I was too scared to tell anyone. After Jesus died, God gave me the courage to ask Pilate for Jesus' body and bury Him. *(John 19:38)*

I was also too scared to admit that I believed in Jesus while He was alive. Jesus had told me that He would be "lifted up" so that whoever believed in Him would have eternal life. After Jesus died, I courageously identified myself as His follower and brought the myrrh and aloes to bury Jesus with. *(John 3:1-21 & 19:39)*

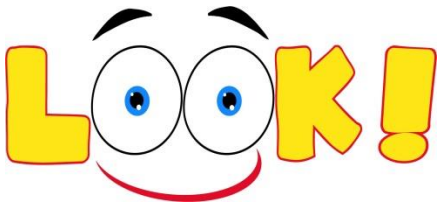

“EMPTY TOMB” ROLLS

YIELDS 8 ROLLS



Empty Tomb Rolls or Marshmallow Delights - easy cinnamon sugar rolls with a melting marshmallow inside. These are a great symbolic dessert recipe for Easter.

PREP TIME 10 minutes
COOK TIME 15 minutes
TOTAL TIME 25 minutes

INGREDIENTS

- 1 (8 ounce or 12 ounce) package refrigerated crescent rolls (the bigger size makes it a little easier to wrap around the marshmallow)
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 8 large marshmallows
- 1/4 cup butter, melted

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Separate rolls into eight triangles. Combine sugar and cinnamon. Dip each marshmallow into butter, roll in cinnamon-sugar and place on a triangle. Pinch dough around marshmallow, sealing all edges. Make sure to seal well or all the marshmallow will escape.
2. Dip tops of dough into remaining butter and cinnamon-sugar. Place with sugar side up in greased muffin cups. It helps to use jumbo muffin tins so that the juice doesn't overflow.
3. Bake at 375 degrees for 10 to 15 minutes or until rolls are golden brown. Allow to cool slightly then eat warm.

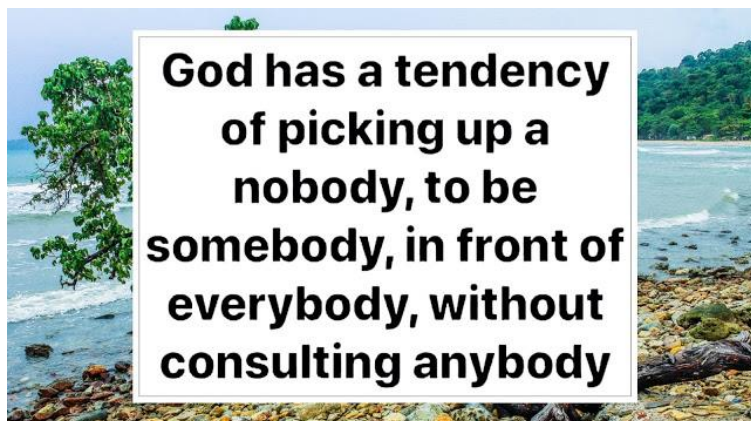
